DEAR FELLOW AIM MEMBERS,

Looking back, it is hard to really take stock of 2022. It's hard to imagine that one year ago we were worrying about Omicron and people were still wearing masks everywhere. It's hard to imagine how quickly our worries and focus turned to war.

2022 was a hard year, but it was one that we in AIM can be proud of. On February 26th our companies began responding to requests from the government and Moldova For Peace for support coping with the massive refugee crisis that had begun. By February 27th we had partnered with Peace Corps Moldova to run a donation center to collect supplies. I personally never imagined that this initiative would transition into a months long effort that would wind up supporting over 38,000 refugees. Members lent their trucks, their equipment, their time and their energy to help in a very dark time.

Throughout 2022 AIM worked with government ministries advocating for small business as the state planned crisis response efforts. 2023 is also likely to be a hard year. A year of high inflation and still lots of uncertainty. At the same time we hope for things getting better. As small business owners we are natural optimists – it's part of the job. At AIM we are looking forward to 2023, optimistic about a better year. A year for real reforms to make it easier to do business and to support a better economic environment for all. A year when we can finally put COVID behind us and when we can hope for peace.

In partnership with AIM and Peace Corps Moldova, the NGO friends of Moldova. Together we have helped over 38.000 Ukrainians:

- 7.847 individual or refugee families.


